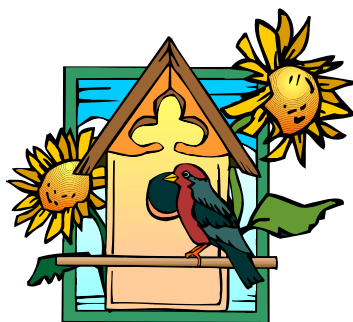

**Class lists and rooms will be posted on the bulletin board across from the main office by Thursday, March 11, 2010.**

**NEW! Braille** *\$145*

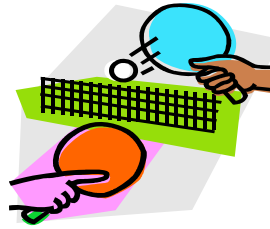

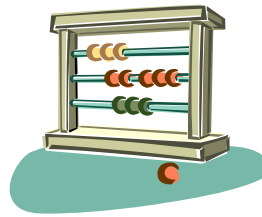
**Table Tennis**      *limited to 12 students \$135*
