WORKSHOP CHOICES

- 1. I'm Melting -- The Perils of Global Warming** Students from HGHS Silent Earth will present a workshop on Global Warming and its effect on the present and the future.
- 2. Earth's Sunscreen -- The Ozone Layer** Bell MS students will evaluate good v. bad ozone through an interactive activity and short presentation. Then they will demonstrate the effects of bad ozone and how to monitor ozone levels using natural biological indicators using samples from Bell's Ozone Garden.
- 3. emPOWERing the Future** Students from HGHS STOP will explore energy efficiency in our schools and homes and will examine the benefits of alternative energy sources.
- 4. Water, Water Everywhere and Not a Drop to Drink** Bell Environmental Club members will address water use and abuse in everyday life and outline steps we can all take to keep our waterways clean.
- 5. Blowing in the Wind** This workshop will be a hands-on approach to discovering wind energy. Students from SB KAP will provide materials and instruction to build a small wind turbine and measure electrical output.
- 6. Sustainable Ideas for Sustainable Life** Students from the SB Environmental Club will present a collection of ideas to help you lead a more sustainable lifestyle both at home and school.
- 7. Mobilize for Earth Day** 5th and 7th Grade Girl Scouts will help participants create collaborative environmentally-friendly mobiles representing life on Earth today and in the future.
